Downtown Charleston offers a myriad of activities for visitors to explore, from historic sites and cultural landmarks to charming boutiques and award-winning dining establishments.

#### Historic Landmarks:

 Immerse yourself in the rich history of Charleston by visiting iconic landmarks such as the Battery & White Point Garden, Fort Sumter National Monument, and the Nathaniel Russell House Museum.

#### **Cultural Attractions:**

- Explore the city's vibrant arts scene by visiting renowned galleries like the Gibbes Museum of Art and the Halsey Institute of Contemporary Art.
- Lowcountry Art Gallery, Helena Fox Fine Art Gallery, and Miller Gallery have all been top spots for art collectors. Also notable are Hagan, The George, and Reinert Fine Art. Hagan and Reinert are next to each other!

#### Shopping:

- Wander through the historic streets of King Street, lined with boutique shops, antique stores, and designer boutiques, offering everything from fashion and jewelry to home decor and artisanal goods.
  - <u>Copper Penny</u>: a curated selection of trendy clothing, shoes, and accessories, Copper Penny caters to fashion-forward women looking for chic and stylish pieces.
  - Gwynns of Mt. Pleasant: luxury department store featuring designer fashion, accessories, and beauty products catering to sophisticated women.
  - Sewing Down South: has some cute throw pillows and home decor.
  - <u>Lake Pajamas</u>: comfortable and stylish sleepwear, including pajama sets, loungewear, and accessories
- Other shops to note: The Keep Shop, Shirtini, and so many spots to stop along the way! You will also find all of the norm stores as well!
- Explore the historic City Market, where vendors sell a variety of locally made crafts, artwork, and souvenirs.
